Eagle Dies offer the commercial printer options in both through-cutting and kisscutting of stocks up to .040 thick. Eagle Dies may also be incorporated in a standard steel rule die as an insert, giving flexibility for easily changeable designs like windows and decorative edges. Kisscutting pressure sensitive materials such as wall clings, coupon inserts, and stickers is also more consistent due to a continuous cutting edge achieved in manufacturing, eliminating the problems caused from natural nicks from the joints in steel rule dies.
